



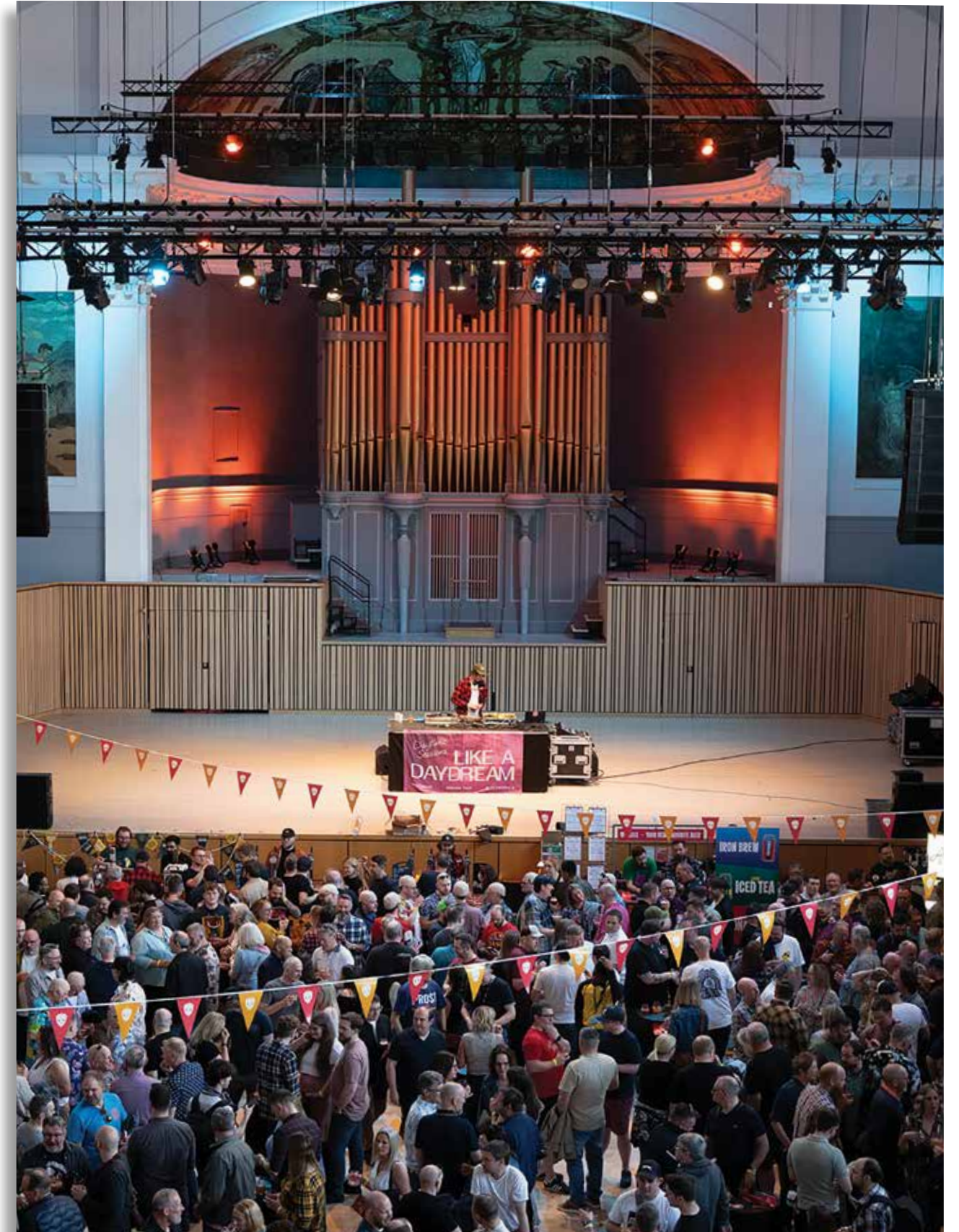

About us

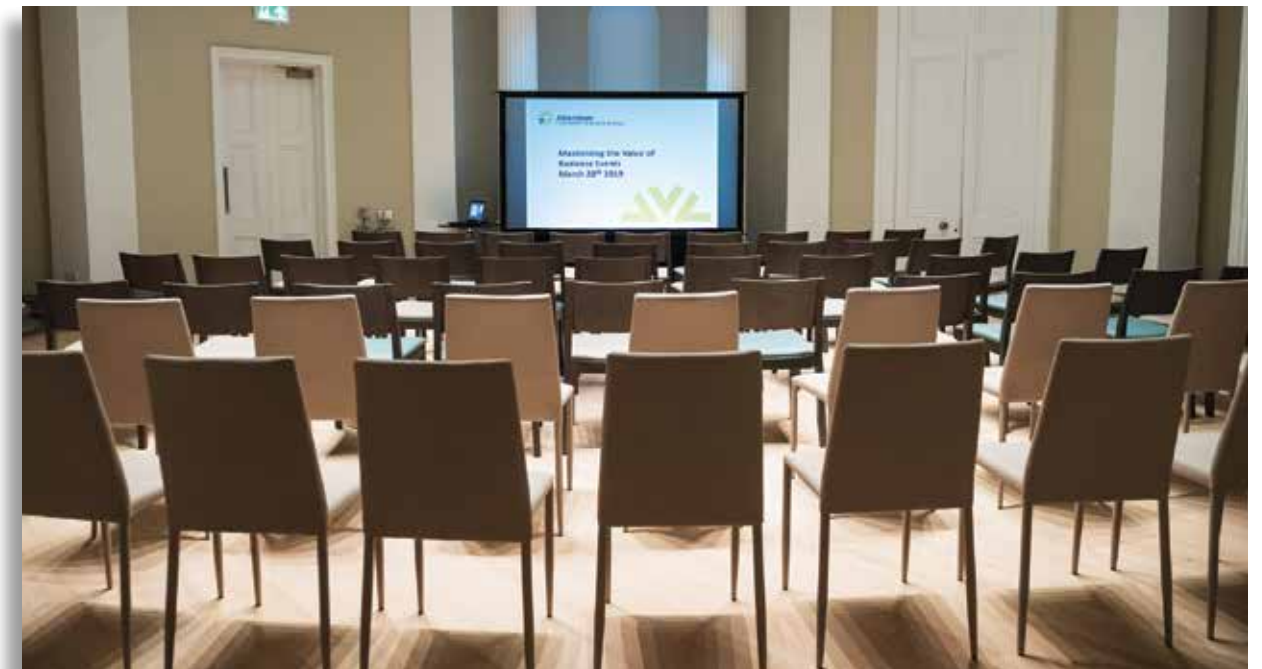


Aberdeen Performing Arts is a multi-award winning, multi-site, arts charity right in the heart of the North-east of Scotland.

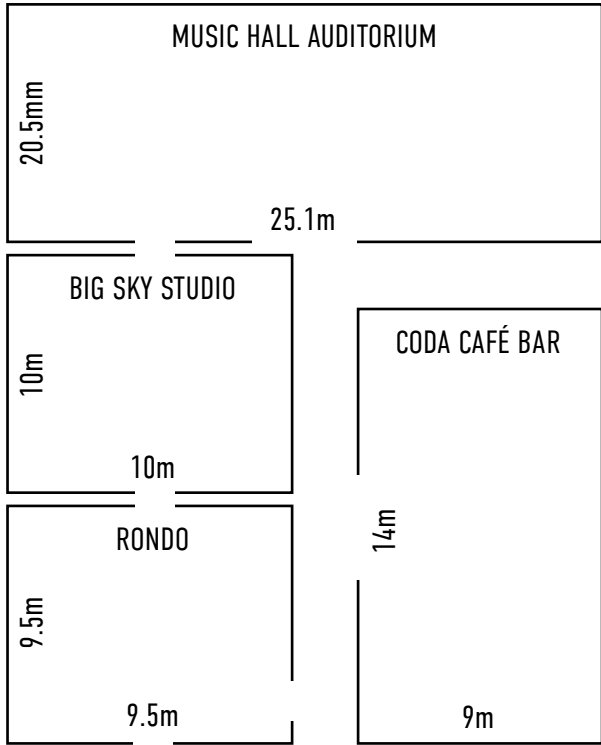

An Edwardian masterpiece, this beautiful category A listed theatre has been a landmark location in the city since it opened in 1906, attracting world-class shows and performers ever since. HMT's stunning auditorium was described by Billy Connolly as a gigantic wedding cake! Our contemporary Terrace Restaurant is also available for hire subject to show schedules.

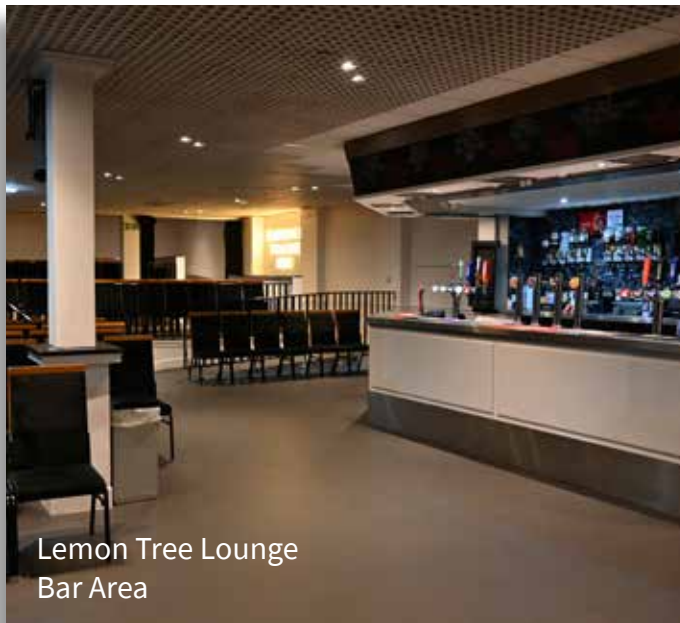


Q: What do The Libertines, Lewis Capaldi, Sarah Millican and Radiohead have in common?

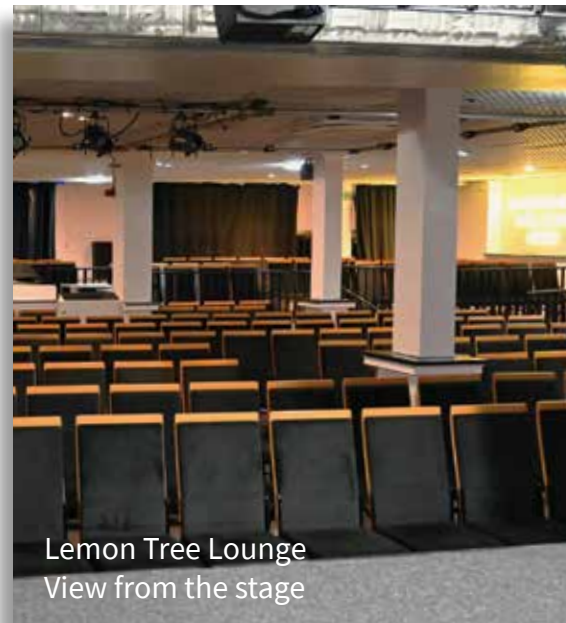
A: They have all taken to the stage at the Lemon Tree for the first time before going on to fill arenas, win awards and grace our TV screens.

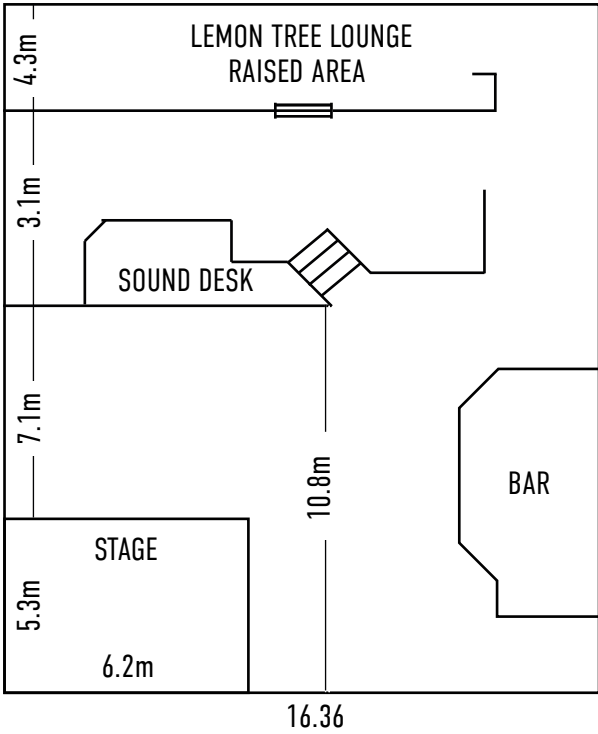

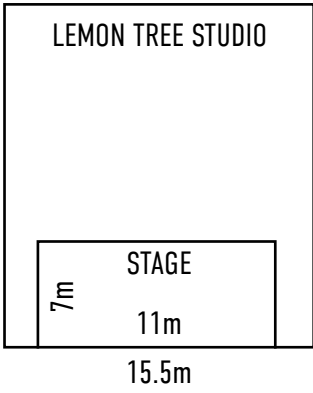

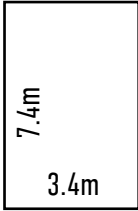

As well as this impressive external offering we pride ourselves in bringing the best programme in various art forms to the North East direct from the West-End & beyond.

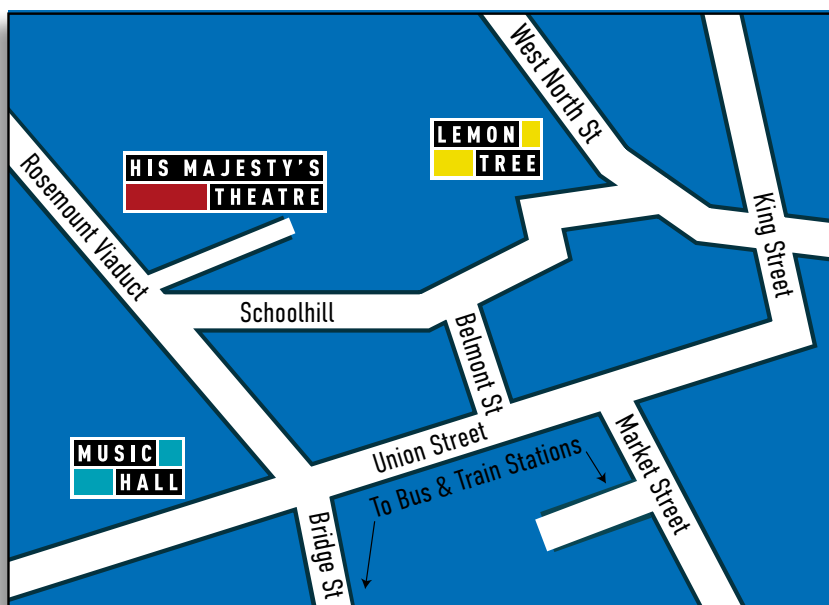
